1. ORGANISATION

JUMPY asbl organises on August 10 and 11 2024 an old-style enduro event called the "2 jours de Stavelot Revival". This event will be run in accordance with the FMB Sporting Code and its appendices, and these Supplementary Regulations.

2. ORGANISING COMMITTEE

The organisation is ensured by JUMPY asbl.

3. OFFICIALS

Race Director: Corneille BAGUETTE Assistant: Philippe MARQUET Safety Officer: JUMPY asbl Technical Manager: Jeff THYRION

4. PARTICIPANTS

The "2 Jours de Stavelot" are open to all riders whose commitment will be retained by the organisation. The registration fee is set at €160 for the two days. This price includes:

- Participation in the enduro
- Individual insurance and civil liability
- Transponder rental
- Access to the Bikers'Party, Saturday evening meal + 2 drinks
- A souvenir cap

The maximum number of machines allowed is 250.

5. REGISTRATION REQUEST

Registration can only be done online via: <u>https://booking.dgsport.eu/en/60-enduro-classic-</u>2-jours-stavelot-revival

The amount of the registration is fixed at 160€ for the 2 days.

Entry fees must be paid on registration via Worldline or within 14 days by bank transfer.

6. CANCELLATION OF REGISTRATION

Any cancellation of registration must be notified in writing to the secretary of the organisation before July 10. Registration will be refunded at 50% up to one month before the event. After this date, there will be no refund.

7. CANCELLATION OF THE EVENT

The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event.

8. CATEGORIES

Motorcycles must meet one of these categories and fully retain the specifications of that time.

- A/ Up to and including year of construction 1970
 - Class 1: 50/75cc
 - Class 2: 100/125cc
 - Class 3: + 125cc
- B / From year of construction 1971 to year of construction 1975 inclusive
 - Class 4: 50/75cc
 - Class 5: 100/125cc
 - Class 6: 175cc
 - Class 7: + 175cc

• C / From year of construction 1976 to year of construction 1980 inclusive

- Class 8: 50/75cc
- Class 9: 100/125cc
- Class 10: 175cc
- Class 11: 250cc
- Class 12: + 250cc

• D / From year of construction 1981 to year of construction 1991 inclusive

- Class 13: 50/80cc
- Class 14: 100/125/175cc
- Class 15: + 175cc
- E/ Ladies

9. MOTORCYCLES

Motorcycles must be:

- compliant with the highway code,
- registered,
- insured.

A small number plate during the event is tolerated.

The government plate can be requested at the TC.

Sidecars and similar are not allowed.

10. RIDERS

An enduro licence issued by the FMB is required:

- 1-event licence purchased in advance via My FMB-BMB (Price: 35€ for Belgian residents, 45€ for foreigners*)
- On-site 1-event licence (Price: €50 for Belgian residents, €60 for foreigners*)
- Annual FMB classic enduro licence (Price: 145€)

Click <u>HERE</u> to apply for a licence from the FMB - Fédération Motocycliste de Belgique.

To this cost must be added club membership (Club organisateur JUMPY asbl, 25€ per year). *Foreign riders may take part with their national licence and a start authorisation issued by a national federation affiliated to the FIM.

The wearing of motorbike clothing, helmet with E3 homologation, boots, gloves, blouse or long-sleeved jacket is compulsory.

11. ADMINISTRATIVE CONTROL

The administrative control will take place on Friday August 9 from 3:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and on Saturday August 10 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. in the paddock of the Spa-Francorchamps circuit.

The documents necessary for the competition will be given to the competitors on presentation of the following regulatory documents:

- Confirmation of registration
- Insurance & motorcycle registration certificate
- Driver's license
- The European assistance card

12. TECHNICAL CONTROL

Technical control will be held on Friday August 9 from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and on Saturday morning August 10 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. in the paddock of the Spa-Francorchamps circuit.

During this control, the following will be checked:

- Front and rear lights in working order
- Brakes in working order
- Folding footrests
- The correct application of the starting numbers.
 These must be fixed by the rider to the front and to the sides.
 Only the front start number is provided by the organiser.
- Decibels: MAXIMUM 94DB (More than 94 DB = penalty points, more than 110 DB = no start)
- The correct installation of the transponder. It must be mounted on the front right.

The choice of tires

Enduro DOT and or "E" tires on the H=13mm sidewall or tires that resemble the old enduro profile are authorised - Cross tires are forbidden.

There is no parc fermé on Friday evening.

All participating motorcycles MUST be in the parc fermé on Saturday morning by 08:00 at the latest. Any minute late will be penalised with one point.

13. TRANSPONDER

It must be withdrawn by the rider at the administrative control leaving his identity card as a deposit. It must be placed on the fork tube on the right side.

Warning! In case of loss or damage to the transponder = 250€

14. TIMING

Friday August 9:

• Access to the car park on the perimeter of the circuit starts at 3:00 p.m. Each participant will have to pick up their access pass at the Welcome Center which will be located at the Karting de Spa-Francorchamps to be able to access the Spa-Francorchamps Circuit. You will then be directed by the organiser.

• Once installed, you can go to the administrative control. A detailed plan of the administrative and technical control as well as the paddocks allocated to the Enduro will be sent approximately 15 days prior to the event.

• The Technical Control will take place from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on the site of the circuit.

• No parc fermé, Friday evening

Saturday August 10:

- Access to the circuit from 7:00 a.m.
- The Administrative and Technical Control will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.
- The mandatory briefing will be given at 8:45 a.m. and the location will be communicated to you during the administrative check.
- The first competitors start at 9:30 am at the rate of 2 riders per minute.
- The Saturday route consists of 1 loop of 100 km plus 4 special stages.
- The parade on the circuit will take place at 6:30 p.m. and all participants are invited.
- In the evening, the motorcycle must be placed in the parc fermé before 8:00 p.m.

The operation of the lights will be checked.

In case of non-compliance, the competitor will be inflicted penalty points.

If a problem is identified with the exhaust, for example the loss of the silencer, the competitor will be disqualified.

Sunday August 11:

• Access to the parc fermé only 15 minutes before departure time, upon presentation of the withdrawal card.

• The first competitors start at 9:00 a.m. at the rate of 2 drivers per minute.

- The Sunday route consists of a 60 km loop plus 4 special stages.
- At the end of the race, the motorcycle must be returned to the parc fermé.

Competitors can pick up their motorcycle only half an hour after the arrival of the last participant.

The operation of the lights will be checked. In case of non-compliance, the competitor will be inflicted penalty points.

If a problem is identified with the exhaust, for example the loss of the silencer, the competitor will be disqualified.

• The announcement of the results and awarding of prizes will take place from 6:00 p.m.

15. COURSE OF THE EVENT

• Competitors will complete a TT circuit, on roads and paths accessible to all. The highway code applies and the signs must be respected.

• In villages and surrounding areas, speed may be controlled.

• Refuelling can only be done on an environmental mat. Penalty points will be applied in case of non-compliance. Refuelling can be done after the first 40km loop before arriving in the circuit paddock and before the time check in the riders' park.

• In addition to the starting procedure, which is considered a test, there are 4 different special tests which are all eligible for the establishment of results.

16. PENALTIES

• A departure penalty depending on the participant's age will be applied. We attribute 100 starting penalty points to each participant, from which we deduct the age of the participant concerned. Example: 62-year-old driver: 100-62 = 38 penalty points. 36-year-old driver: 100- 36 years old = 64 penalty points

• 1 point = 1 second

• The start: in the minute following the start, the competitor, with the engine running, must cover a distance of 20 meters. If the engine does not start or starts too late: 2 penalty points. If the participant starts the engine too early: 5 penalty points.

• The non-stop: 1 foot = 1 point / 2 feet = 2 points / 3 feet or more = 3 points / riding out of zone or failure = 5 points / refusing the test = 10 points

• Slalom:

- a) The course is timed. Each second equals one point (100ths are rounded up) Example: 1 minute 35 seconds = 95 points.
- b) Knock over or move a cone = 1 point per cone.
- c) Making a mistake on the course by missing one or more cones = 5 points.
- d) Braking outside the braking zone = 10 points
- Acceleration/braking test:
 - a) The course is timed. Each second is a point (100ths are rounded) ex 2 minutes 35 seconds = 155 points.
 - b) Braking outside the braking zone = 10 points.

c) Exceeding the maximum authorised number of decibels = 2 points per Db. Example
 96dba = 2X2 = + 4 penalty points.

• Enduro test: The course is timed. Each second equals one point (100ths are rounded) ex 2 minutes 35 seconds = 155 points.

- Other penalty points:
 - a) Motorcycle presented late in the parc fermé = 1 penalty point per minute late
 - b) Lights not working = 5 points (The control is carried out at the entrance to the parc fermé on Saturday evening and on Sunday at the end of the event)
 - c) Exhaust or muffler broken or lost = disqualification
 - d) Absence during the briefing = prohibited to start

17. RANKING AND AWARDS

The classification is made by year of construction, all displacements combined. A trophy is provided for the first of each class.

- A trophy will be awarded to the first 3 participating ladies.
- A trophy will be offered to the oldest participant.
- Each participant will receive a souvenir.

18. MODIFICATIONS

These rules are subject to change at any time. The main changes will be announced at the latest during the administrative check.
